## What is Ordinarily, available provision?

It can be defined as the provision made for children whose special educational needs can be met from the resources generally available to the school or setting. This will apply to all children without an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP) but children with an EHCP will also benefit from this type of provision.

The DfE in the SEND and AP publication make it clear that they want more schools to meet need through OAP.
