# What is bullying behaviour?

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Bullying behaviour is:

- **Hurtful**
- **On purpose**
- **Repeated**

It can be:

- Saying mean things
- Leaving someone out
- Hitting or pushing
- Being unkind online or on devices

We link this to our school rules:

- **Be Safe**
- **Be Respectful**



# Bullying or falling out?

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## **Falling out (conflict):**

- Happens once or not often
- Both children upset
- Similar power
- Can be fixed with help

## **Bullying behaviour:**

- Happens again and again
- One child has more power
- Someone feels scared or unhappy
- Needs adult help





What should  
you do?

Children are taught to:

- Say **Stop**
- Walk away
- **Tell a trusted adult**
- Keep telling until it stops

*We reinforce that telling is not tattling —  
it is how we keep everyone safe.*





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# Who can you talk to?

- Any trusted grown-up in school
- You can talk to the schools trusted adult such as Mr Mikelson, Ms. Luu or Mrs Titchmarsh.



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# What will adults do?

Adults will:

- Listen and believe you
- Check what has happened
- Help you feel safe
- Help the other child learn better behaviour
- Talk to parents if needed
