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Dear Parents / Carers

We've had a wonderful start to the year, what a joy its been to welcome all of our pupils back.

Our EYFS children are adapting well to being in school full time. They have particularly enjoyed spending time outside, on the grass area and on the stage. So far children have learnt the S,A,T,P sounds as well as focusing on the number zero.

Year 1 have been reading The Three Little Pigs and the children have been making their own puppets to re-tell the story. They have just started making their own versions of the characters with alternatives such as 'The Three Little Princess Kittens and the Big Bad Peacock'.

Year 2 had a surprise visit from an alien who landed in class with a plate and a spoon. This has lead to lots of discussions with the children and also links into their English learning about spaceman Ray. They have also been enjoying making number lines and working out missing numbers.

Year 3 have been enjoying learning all about the Mayans and have been busy in designing and making their own Mayan masks.

Year 4 have been reading Greek myths and have even begun writing a wholeclass version of Daedalus and Icarus! They have even learnt it by heart using our 'talking hands'.

Year 5 have been refining their descriptive writing skills using settings from the text Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo. In science, they have been developing their knowledge of life cycles and have begun comparing those of mammals, amphibians, insects and birds.

Year 6 have had a fantastic start to the year. They have been practicing their atmospheric writing and finishing a story about a hare fighting in World War II. They have also been developing their research skills, looking into what they are most interested in about the World War and what they would like to learn over this term.

MATCH FUNDRAISING

FOBS are looking for match fundraisers for our upcoming Christmas Fayre, we are looking for those of you who's companies offer matched fundraising.
