

Year 3 News

In Art this half term, the children have been exploring cave paintings, using different techniques to create their own versions inspired by prehistoric artists.







In French, we have begun our language journey by learning basic greetings and practising simple conversational exchanges.

History lessons have introduced prehistory, where pupils are discovering life in the Stone Age and Bronze Age.

In Religious Studies, we have been discussing what makes us human and encouraging thoughtful conversations around values and identity. We are also pleased to share that the children are now using pens instead of pencils for their written work, marking an exciting step in their progress.

In Science, our focus has been movement and nutrition, exploring how our bodies work and what helps us stay healthy.

In Maths, we are revisiting place value and working with numbers up to 1000 to secure confidence with larger numbers.

English has introduced the use of paragraphs and prepositions, using Floella Benjamin's Coming to England as inspiration for writing. As this newsletter arrives, we will also be enjoying our class trip to Flag Fen to bring our history learning to life.
