As we come to the end of a fantastic Spring term, we want to take a moment to celebrate the incredible achievements of our Year 3 pupils. They have worked so hard across all areas of the curriculum, and we are immensely proud of their dedication and enthusiasm for learning.

The children all performed brilliantly in their assessments, demonstrating their growing confidence and understanding across subjects. Their commitment to their studies has been truly commendable.

In Art, the children showcased their creativity by designing and sculpting fantastic clay models inspired by the illustrations of Quentin Blake and the bugs from James and the Giant Peach. Their attention to detail and perseverance in shaping their models were wonderful to see.

In Maths, we have been focusing on fractions, and the children have made excellent progress in not only solving fraction problems but also explaining their reasoning clearly and confidently. It has been great to see their mathematical thinking develop.
