Year 1 and Year 2 News

We've had a fantastic start to the term and wanted to share some of the exciting learning that's been happening in our classroom.

English

We've been reading Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers, which the children have thoroughly enjoyed. It's led to some lovely discussions about adventures and what we might take with us. We've also been learning to use adjectives to describe different places. The children are now using these skills to write their own imaginative stories about a lost animal.

Maths

This term, our focus has been on addition and subtraction:

- In **Year 1**, we've been exploring different ways to make numbers under 10 using practical methods and games.
- In **Year 2**, we've been learning how to split tens and ones to help add two-digit numbers, even up to 100!

History

We've been comparing childhood today with childhood in the past. The children really enjoyed looking at photos from their teachers' younger years and hearing stories about what school was like in the 1960s. It's been a great way to bring history to life.

Design & Technology (DT)

We had a fun and tasty time making our own fruit salads. The children practiced safe cutting techniques and then evaluated what they liked and didn't like. It was a great hands-on experience.

Science

We've been using our senses to explore the world around us. The children had the chance to taste different foods and feel a variety of textures, helping them understand how we use our senses every day.

We're so proud of how enthusiastic and engaged the children have been, and we're looking forward to many more exciting lessons as the year continues.
