Special Message from the Local Authority

Risk warning notice - `salt and ice' social media craze

Parent and carer alert about the 'salt and ice challenge'

A dangerous online trend is resurfacing where children put salt on their skin and press ice on top. This causes serious cold burns (like frostbite). Injuries can require hospital treatment and even skin grafts, and children may not realise the damage until it's too late.

First aid: Cool with lukewarm running water for 10+ minutes, cover with clean cling film and seek medical help.

Do **not** use ice, creams, or fluffy dressings.
