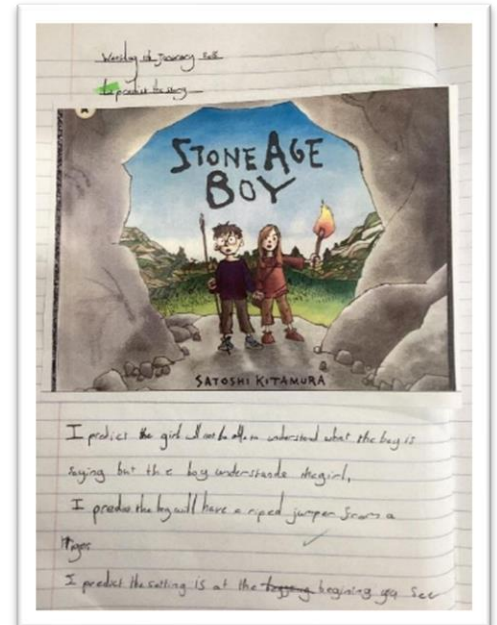

Year 3 News

English

In English, we are focusing on writing a narrative story inspired by *Stone Age Boy*. The children are using their historical knowledge from our Autumn Term 1 history work to help them include accurate settings, characters, and events in their writing.



Maths

In maths, we are learning about multiplication and division. The children are using their times table knowledge to support their understanding and to solve a range of problems with increasing confidence.

Science

In science, we have started our unit on rocks and soils. The children carried out a science experiment to test the absorbency of different rocks and to see whether they would react to "acid rain" (using white vinegar). We have also used a rock classification sheet to help identify and compare the different rocks we have been studying.



Art

In art, we have begun exploring sculpture. The children are using cardboard to transform 2D shapes into 3D sculptures, experimenting with joining techniques and creating a range of different forms and structures.



Enrichment

Last week, we had the pleasure of taking part in a scootering workshop. The children thoroughly enjoyed the session, and it was lovely to have Ms Luu joining in and supporting the workshop as well.



This has been a busy and exciting week of learning across the curriculum.

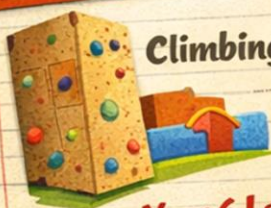
