Last week we held our sharing assembly and the children really enjoyed speaking to everyone who was able to come about their learning. It was brilliant to see the children speaking so confidently and happily about their work. Thank you to everyone who was able to attend.

In English we are continuing to look at 'The Paperbag Prince' developing our English persuasive writing skills alongside our knowledge of recycling and sustainability. The children have really impressed us with their knowledge of sustainability and shown great maturity when thinking about this as a global issue.

In maths we have moved onto looking at translations and will be spending the remaining maths lessons up to half term on this area. The children are also developing their maths mastery skills by identifying patterns and trends and then explaining and justifying their answers with evidence.

Last term in DT we were thinking about structures and how to ensure that bridges are rigid and lightweight. Our own bridges had mixed results however we were able to think about why some were more successful than others and further our learning this way.


