KS1 News

This week **in English** we have taken on the role of tour guides in London Tour Guides and have been taking visitors around the busy, bustling city of London. We have been writing about our tours, remembering to use our Mastery Keys – using conjunctions 'and', 'but, 'or', adverbs, punctuation and commas in a list. We have visited famous landmarks like the Houses of Parliament, Tower Bridge, Big Ben and The London Eye. Ask the children what they know about London landmarks!

In Maths, we have begun our new unit on shape. We have been naming 2D shapes and understanding their different properties. We have used rulers and dotted paper to draw our own shapes.

In Science, we have been continuing to learn about materials and their properties. This week we tested the absorbency of six different materials. We also carried out an experiment in groups and recorded what we found out in a table.

In Art, we have been learning about different lines. Can your child name the 6 different lines? We are moving onto using lines to create drawings. We have also learnt about two artists – Bridget Riley and Paul Klee. We particularly enjoyed looking at Brigitte Riley's optical illusions.

We are all getting excited about Christmas and have been learning our first Christmas song in singing assembly this week. We hope that many of you are able to attend the Christmas Fayre today.

Thank you for being patient whilst we regroup the children for phonics. These groups are still being finalised, but the children should be bringing home a new reading book today.
