It has been another busy week of learning in school. We have focused on improving handwriting across the school. During RWInc. lessons, we are going back to ensure prior handwriting skills are secure such as letter formation before moving on to word writing fluency. We use the Nelson Handwriting scheme from EYFS to Year 6 as this gives us consistency in school. Another way that we encourage good handwriting and work presentation is in the launch of our new Presentation Pioneer Award. Each week, teachers select pupils who have shown excellent effort in improving their handwriting and work presentation. We hope that you are going to support us with reinforcing the importance of handwriting and presentation when children do their homework and writing at home.

We had our Reception 2025 Open Events this week. It was great to have many prospective parents and carers visiting our EYFS setting. 

#### **Year 2 News**

This week in year two we've been continuing our work on addition and subtraction in maths. This has focussed on adding and subtracting ones from two-digit numbers and representing our work as bar models. In English we have continued to work on our Narrative unit, looking at how stories are constructed, as well as work on tenses and compound words.
